

Gleaning: Participation Model

The principle that God asks farmers to leave food at the edges of their fields for the poor or foreigner to come gather

Seeking participation in solutions and creativity to use God-given gifts A model used after crisis has been resolved (relief, recovery, development) Encourages self-sufficiency and stewardship


Moral Proximity

Guest Services

- Helping Guests Check In & Out
- First Face of Resource Center
- Provides Instructions for Shopping
- Collects donations after shopping
- Weighs and records visit in 'Services'

Let's Shop – Market & Boutique

- 1. Guest Completes Intake New or Returning : serve68.org/ventureintake
- 2. Check the form was submitted correctly: serve68.org/caredata
- 3. Provide shopping instructions, mention any food specials or other ministries available that day
- 4. Guests shop for items by their needs, following recommended amounts
- 5. Weigh Food / Clothing separately
- 6. Based upon items, let guest know the recommended donation amount and place in coin box
- 7. Record visit as 'check out': serve68.org/caredata



Shopping Guidelines

- One basket for food; one basket for clothing
 - \$1 / Ib of clothing & \$5 for a basket of food
 - Best to talk with a guest about any limits before check out
- Household items shelf: individually marked donation amount
- Fresh Foods & Diapers: dependent on resources available
- Participation Model Exceptions (first few visits, crisis, relational reasons)
- Volunteer Shopping
 - Follow same guidelines
 - Shop towards or at end of shift from items available to all other families


