



SERVE 6.8 Memorandum of Understanding

It is important that the family involved clearly understand the following information.

Please read and sign below:

SERVE 6.8 is a non-profit organization with the Community Impact Program that uses volunteers to work with clients to make needed home repairs and accomplish requested projects. Actions taken by SERVE 6.8 are being done as an act of love for God and as an act of service to the client. We are people serving our community to demonstrate God's love in tangible ways to people in Northern Colorado with no strings attached. Our volunteers are not professionals and receive no pay for their time.

It is possible that SERVE 6.8 will determine that a project is beyond the scope of volunteer work. In order to preserve our volunteer base and still accomplish a requested project to assist a client, SERVE 6.8 might choose to enlist the assistance of a paid company.

This Memorandum of Understanding is to release SERVE 6.8 to make decisions about bringing in a volunteer team or hiring a professional company to do the work. It will also allow SERVE 6.8 to make decisions about what items in the home are suitable for donation to our ministry or another ministry in the area, and what items must be taken to a landfill.

The client releases SERVE 6.8, its staff, and volunteers from any liability for personal injury to anyone on the property and for property damage.
